**SHELL GORE BAY TERMINAL  
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

In August this year Shell Refining confirmed that its refinery operation at Clyde will cease by mid 2013. This decision will impact on the range of product imported through its Gore Bay terminal.

The terminal has operated principally as a crude import terminal but, after the changes at Clyde, importation of crude will cease. Shell is in the process of resolving exactly what products will be unloaded and stored at Gore Bay. It has confirmed that future imported product will include gasoline but, at a public meeting held on December 1, Shell advised that it has yet to make a decision as to the possible storage of gasoline at the Gore Bay site.

During the course of recent public meetings convened by Shell, it has become evident that members of the Greenwich community would like to know more about the emergency management plans for the Shell site.

Coordination of this emergency management function is handled through the Local Emergency Management Committee.

The NSW Fire Brigade and NSW Police, who are both represented on the Local Emergency Management Committee, have agreed to brief the Greenwich community on details of the emergency management plans for the Shell site. Representatives of Shell will also take part in the briefing.

This presentation will take place at 7pm on Wednesday December 14 at the Greenwich Community Centre, 46 Greenwich Road.
