### LANE COVE DRAFT DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN

The Association welcomed the opportunity to hear from the Council's Strategic Planner, Stephanie Bashford, about the rationale behind the CDCP and, in particular, the specific section relating to the Greenwich Conservation Area.

In response to discussion at the meeting, the Association made a submission to Council in which it sought to highlight those features of the whole of the Greenwich area that give the locality its character and that should be preserved through the Council's planning instruments.

It is understood that Council will come back to the community after it has had the opportunity to review the draft CDCP. It is anticipated that there will be further opportunity for community involvement in this process.
