Waterbrook Update

The first of Waterbrook's construction newsletters has now been published. All residents in adjoining streets should have received a copy.

We now await the issuance of a Construction Certificate before any building works can commence. There are several requirements that must first be met by the developer, as specified by Council when the development was approved.

Meanwhile, the developer has an application before Council to, among other things, vastly increase the amount of excavation and the number of truck movements. These matters will be debated at Council on 5th December.
