**GREENWICH SHOPPING PRECINCT
UPGRADE PLAN REVEALED!**

Residents will recall that Council has approved a total budget of \$480,000 to upgrade the Greenwich shopping precinct over a two year period. In recent months residents have had the opportunity to view various plans generated by Council staff and to discuss these plans with Council representatives at Association meetings. There has been significant interest in the detail of the project – numbers at Association meetings have been extremely high. Public comment on the proposed plans was due by November 5 and many members of the community made submissions to Council. A final version of the upgrade plan has been settled in consultation with out East Ward Councillors, with a view to commencing work in early 2011. This plan will be unveiled at the Association meeting on 8 December.
